IM/RU internal KPIs

many indicators, for different purposes, frequent per se not comparable to other companies

RFC KPIs – few indicators, focus on capacity, operation and market, yearly comparable to other corridors

PRIME KPIs – a comprehensive set, focus on outputs, yearly comparable to other Infrastructure Managers

EC RMMS KPIs – focus on outputs, yearly comparable to other Member States

Example - Punctuality



Punctuality at the company level daily, weekly, monthly, by lines, by services ...

Punctuality of corridor trains yearly average at origin and at destination

Punctuality, IMs causes only yearly average, by main segments

Punctuality of national railways yearly average, by main segments

The Story of Freight KPIs - Update


- Presentation of PRIME draft KPI catalog by chair of PRIME SG KPIs.
 - Exchange of information between PRIME SG KPIs \Leftrightarrow SG Int. Freight
- Decision on pragmatic approach for a set of KPI for RFCs.
- Basis for discussion:
 - RNE KPI obligatory
 - ERFA KPI proposal
 - ECCO KPI proposal
- Set of KPIs agreed by SG International Freight.
 - ✓ Presentation to customers → ESC
 - ✓ Presentation and start a discussion on the SG IF-proposal (updated version of the ECCO-proposal) in the joint meeting of RFCs/RNE & ECCO Group.
 - Start a discussion with PRIME SG KPI (January 18th, 2017)
 - ✓ 2nd joint discussion of RUs (UIC/ECCO Group & RU Dialogue SG IF), Customers (CLECAT), RFCs, IMs, RNE (March 2^{nd} , 2017) \rightarrow Outcome: Preliminary action plan on the proposed freight KPIs.
- Next steps:
 - Approval of action plan to freight KPIs created on the last joint meeting. → Start to implement them with support of PRIME SG KPIs.
