

- Procedure is adequate for new (change of) arrangements



- 4.1. The Agency is of the opinion that Railway Undertakings and Infrastructure Managers should use a harmonized procedure for the implementation of the provisions of Commission Directive 2016/882/EU (...)
- 4.2. Railway Undertakings should use the Application Form in Annex 1 (...)
- 4.3. When preparing derogation requests, applicants should take into account the Application Guidance in Annex II.
- 4.4. Infrastructure managers should assess such derogation requests taking into account the Assessment Guidance in Annex III."

Main Conclusions

- 1. Clear statement regarding 'second language use' being no derogation case

- 3. The subject requires **close cooperation between RU and IM** during entire procedure
